








Kiss of Death Inaugural Cruise Retreat

She's also the past President of RWA's romantic suspense chapter, Kiss of Death, a member of Central Ohio Fiction Writers, and other local writing groups.

John J Goold John Goold is a retired Chief Deputy District Attorney and former peace officer with 45 years experience in California law enforcement and prosecution of all types of criminal cases from theft to multiple murder. He was the Stanislaus County District Attorney's office spokesperson during the case of the People vs Scott Peterson for the murder of his wife Laci Peterson and her unborn child Connor. He will speak on what is involved in investigating and taking criminal cases to jury trial. He will also tell you why Scott Peterson is truly guilty of Laci and Connor's murders.

Krysta Lynne With a degree in History gathering dust, Krysta Lynne spends her free time coloring outside the lines writing novels that range from a writer's notebook which she uses to organize the details of the many projects on her desk to speculative romance, Wiccan inspirational romance, and romantic suspense to small town romance. She believes *plotting* is a bad word, a villainous character deserves a happy ending, and that writing death scenes for all of her characters is a requirement, so that she can push her characters to their breaking point.

A book map is a visual guide to your book. It breaks your story down, chapter by chapter, scene by scene, so you can see exactly what you have—AND what you don't. It allows you to be your own developmental editor. Find out how to create a book map to visually track the plot, characters, conflict, and more, find pacing issues and unnecessary scenes, follow plot lines and discover plot holes, and track character growth throughout the story. Pantsers LOVE this workshop, and plotters do too.

What the Hell am I writing? with Tobi Doyle & SG Redling

Maybe you've got a great story idea, or written a story, and when asked, you're not sure what kind of book it is. Where does it fit on the bookshelf? We'll talk about the different genre promises, and what the readers', publishers', and editors' expectations are.

Several actual case examples will be presented including the notorious crime by Scott Peterson who was convicted of murdering his wife and unborn son.
